About the E-Week

Fall 2018 Stratford Festival E-Week Dates: November 25-December 1, 2018

Based in Stratford, Ontario, the Stratford Festival is internationally known and respected as a leading producer of classic works, contemporary dramas, and musicals, with special emphasis on the plays of William Shakespeare. The Stratford Experiential Learning Week, or E-Week, is an exciting opportunity for advanced theater students in the Department of Theater to work with the Festival on its production of *Coriolanus*, which will be presented at the Hopkins Center in late fall of 2018.

The Department of Theater invites applications for this first experiential Stratford Festival E-Week. Up to six applicants will be selected for the fall of 2018 in the areas of acting, directing, design, stage management, technical production, and dramaturgy. **Two of the students selected will also accompany a faculty advisor to Stratford, Ontario to participate in a 3-day intensive September 28 – October 2, joining students from the Film and English Departments.**
