About the Opportunity

The Department of Theater is excited to announce an experiential learning opportunity for advanced students in the non-performance areas of theater (Stage Management, Directing, Design, Dramaturgy, and/or Technical Production).

Based in Stratford, Ontario, the Stratford Festival is internationally known and respected as a leading producer of classic works, contemporary dramas, and musicals, with special emphasis on the plays of William Shakespeare.

Two students will be selected to travel to Stratford for a 10-week internship between March and early June of 2020. The specific design of the internship will be tailored to the individual student's experience and stated interests.

Housing and travel expenses will be included. The internship will also include a stipend of \$200/week stipend to cover food and other expenses while in residence.
